SEPARATE DEFENDANT NAMEMEDIA'S MOTION TO CANCEL, OR ALTERNATIVELY, TO POSTPONE SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE

- 4. If the Court declines to cancel the conference, NameMedia respectfully requests that it be postponed until such time as the Court may find triable issues of fact with regard to Plaintiff's

claims; both NameMedia and Google, Inc. have filed motions for summary judgment to which Plaintiff filed responses which are, in the estimation of counsel for NameMedia, patently deficient:

5. In the event that the Court declines to cancel or postpone the conference, NameMedia respectfully requests that its representative be allowed to participate by telephone or videoconference, so that NameMedia may avoid the time and expense of travel;

WHEREFORE, NameMedia requests that the settlement conference be cancelled, or alternatively that it be postponed, and if not cancelled or postponed, that its representative be allowed to participate remotely, and for all other relief to which it may be entitled.
